## Chula LINK Scholarship cover the following:

\*Travel from ASEAN not exceed 8,500 baht each leg; from Asia not exceed 12,000 baht each leg; from Europe, Australia and New Zealand as well as Africa not exceed 20,000 Baht each leg; from North and South America not exceed 30,000 Baht each leg. (Arrival date on the ticket must be after the finalist has announced. If arrived Thailand before that, the ticket cannot be reimbursed.)

\*\* Stipend and accommodation per month – once arrive Thailand

\*\*\*Study trip – depends on airfare, inflation, and exchange rate

# Qualifications of Applicants

---

1. Be an international citizen (not holding a Thai passport)
2. Have been admitted to study, or are currently studying in the first semester, in a program of Chulalongkorn University
3. Additional qualifications or conditions shall be in accordance with the criteria prescribed by the relevant academic unit or program



# Documents Required for Application

---

1. A completed application form with a 1-inch photograph attached
2. A photocopy of the international citizenship passport, certified as a true copy and signed.
3. A completed academic transcript issued by the last academic institution that the applicant attended
4. A curriculum vitae
5. A certificate of graduation, if available
6. Two letters of recommendation from the Head, the Director, or the Dean of the institution of the applicant's affiliation, or from the applicant's superiors.
7. A medical certificate
