Scholarship Program for ASEAN or Non-ASEAN countries cover the following:

- **Travel from ASEAN not exceed 8,500 baht each leg; from Asia not exceed 12,000 baht each leg; from Europe, Australia and New Zealand as well as Africa not exceed 20,000 Baht each leg; from North and South America not exceed 30,000 Baht each leg. (Arrival date on the ticket must be after the finalist has announced. If arrived Thailand before that, the ticket cannot be reimbursed.)*
- *** Stipend and accommodation per month – once arrive Thailand*
- ****Study trip – depends on airfare, inflation, and exchange rate*

Eligibility of Applicants

1. Applicants must be international graduate students from ASEAN or Non-ASEAN countries. Faculty members, researchers and academic staff, who will return to teach/work at their home universities after graduation from Chulalongkorn University, are preferred. It should be noted that students from ASEAN or Non-ASEAN countries, who have been studying in any program at Chulalongkorn University for more than one semester, are not eligible to apply for this scholarship.
2. Applicants must have completed a Bachelor's degree or a Master's degree in a field related to the field for which they are applying. A degree certificate and an official academic transcript must be submitted with their application.
3. Applicants must have obtained a grade point average of not lower than 2.75 for their undergraduate studies and not lower than 3.25 for their graduate studies.
4. Applicants must be not be over 40 years of age.
5. Applicants must have a good command of English. A minimum TOEFL score of 500 Paperbased, 173 Computer-based, 61 Internet-based, 60 CU-TEP or IELTS score of 5.0 required.
6. Applicants must be in good health.



Documents Required for Application

1. A completed application form with a 1-inch photograph attached
2. A curriculum vitae
3. A completed academic transcript issued by the last academic institution that the applicant attended (If the GPA must be convert to 4.00 system; all the equivalence document must be attached).
4. A certificate of graduation, if available
5. A photocopy of the applicant's passport.
6. Two letters of recommendation from the Head, the Director or the Dean of the institution of the applicant's affiliation or from the applicant's superiors
7. A medical certificate



Chulalongkorn University's Graduate Scholarship Program for ASEAN or Non-ASEAN Countries

Chulalongkorn University has taken a leading role in implementing interactive collaboration with the international community. In order to further develop academic cooperation between Thailand and foreign countries, the University has established the "Graduate Scholarship Program for ASEAN or Non-ASEAN countries" to provide financial assistance to international students who wish to pursue their higher graduate studies at Chulalongkorn University.

Term of the Scholarships:

1. Two-year Master's degree scholarship
2. Three-year Doctoral degree scholarship

Provisions of the Scholarships:

The scholarships will cover the following:

1. An economy class, round-trip ticket, as actually paid. It should also be noted that
 - 1.1 For students from ASEAN, the airfare of each leg of the trip must not exceed 8,500 Baht;
 - 1.2 For students from Asian countries, the airfare of each leg of the trip must not exceed 12,000 Baht;
 - 1.3 For students from Europe, Australia and New Zealand as well as Africa, the airfare of each leg must not exceed 20,000 Baht;
 - 1.4 For students from North and South America, the airfare of each leg must not exceed 30,000 Baht.
2. Tuition Fees for the University (tuition fees for faculty/special fees by the program, and summer session are excluded : Advanced arrangement between the students and the Faculty/Program is needed.)
3. A monthly stipend and accommodation in the amount of 16,000 Baht.

Conditions of the Scholarships:

1. The term of the scholarships cannot be extended.
2. Recipients of the scholarships are not allowed to defer the period of scholarship acceptance once the scholarship has been granted by the University.
3. Recipients are not allowed to accept any employment in Thailand during the term of the scholarship.

Eligibility of Applicants:

1. Applicants must be international graduate students from ASEAN or Non-ASEAN countries. Faculty members, researchers and academic staff, who will return to teach/work at their home universities after graduation from Chulalongkorn University, are preferred.

It should be noted that students from ASEAN or Non-ASEAN countries, who have been studying in any program at Chulalongkorn University for more than one semester, are not eligible to apply for this scholarship.

2. Applicants must have completed a Bachelor's degree or a Master's degree in a field related to the field for which they are applying. A degree certificate and an official academic transcript must be submitted with their application.

3. Applicants must have obtained a grade point average of not lower than 2.75 for their undergraduate studies and not lower than 3.25 for their graduate studies.

Application Procedures and Period:

2. Applicants must be screened and recruited by the Faculty/Program of their choice before their names are forwarded to the Office of Academic Affairs, Chulalongkorn University. All relevant application documents which have been screened by the Faculty/Program must arrive at the Office of Academic Affairs not later than November 1, 2025.

Appendix

Conditions of Scholarships:

1. The scholarship period **cannot be extended.**
2. The recipients are not permitted to postpone a period of the scholarship acceptance as proposed by Chulalongkorn University.
3. The recipients are not permitted to accept any employment in Thailand during the term of their scholarships. He/She must hold Non-Immigrant "ED".
4. The recipients must residence in Thailand during the scholarship period.

Provisions of the Scholarships :

The scholarships will cover the following :

1. An economy class round-trip air ticket to and from designated capital cities or principal cities of the student's home country to, as actually paid. It should also be noted that

- 1.1 ASEAN not more than 8,500 baht for one way

- 1.2 ASIA not more than 12,000 baht for one way

- 1.3 EUROPE, AUSTRALIA, NEW ZEALAND and AFRICA not more than 20,000 baht for one way

- 1.4 NORTH and SOUTH AMERICA not more than 30,000 baht for one way

Students are required to pay for their tickets and this amount will be reimbursed upon their arrival at Chulalongkorn University. *It should be noted that miscellaneous expenses, which are issued separately and/or the extra expenses; re-schedule flight, seat, meal or beverage are excluded. Please keep all travel relate documents).* The flight arrival to Thailand before the date noted on the Announcement of Chulalongkorn University on the awardees cannot be refund.

2. Tuition Fees for the University (tuition fees for faculty/special fees by the program, and summer session are excluded : Advanced arrangement between the students and the Faculty/Program is needed.)

3. Stipend and accommodation in the amount of 16,000 baht/month. *Please be informed that only those students who are physically located in Thailand are given monthly stipend. Those who are not will receive only the University tuition fee. However, once the student arrives in Thailand, he/she will be entitled for the monthly stipend.*

It should be noted that the scholarship expenses will cover within the scholarship period as stated on the announcement.

Health insurance :

Each international student will be required to pay a group health insurance fee for 2,000 baht per academic year.

Suspension and termination of scholarships :

These scholarships will be suspended or terminated for the following reasons :

1. Serious illness of recipients.

The scholarship recipient is deemed to be seriously ill and not physically fit to carry on with his/her studies.

2. GPA lower than 3.00 of each semester

3. Absence of scholarship recipients without notice or reasonable explanation.

Student departs Thailand for over 10 days without the consent of his/her academic advisor and the approved by the Faculty.

4. Violates the law, or the rules, regulation, announcement or orders issued by the University, or his or her Faculty.
