Application Requirements

1. A completed and signed MM application form. Attach 3.5 cm. x 4.5 cm. recent photographs (.JPEG) (with blue background) taken no more than six months in polite attire or a civil servant's uniform.
2. A current official transcript of academic records
3. A copy of passport showing applicant's name, date of birth, and expiry date
4. An official report of the English proficiency score either
 - TOEFL iBT at minimum score of 79 *or*
 - IELTS at minimum score of 6.5 *or*
 - Common European Framework of Reference (CEFR) at minimum score of B2
5. Two letters of recommendation from former instructors or former/current employers
6. Statement of purpose

Remark: English proficiency scores are valid if they are no more than two years old. If applicants are US, UK, Canada, Australia, and New Zealand citizens, English proficiency score will be exempted.

Application Submission

- To apply for **Fall** Semester, please submit application before on the 1st of May.
- To apply for **Spring** Semester, please submit application before on the 1st of October.

Official Transcript

An exchange student will have to request for an official transcript in order to validate his/her exchange semester. It is 100 baht per copy (no sealed envelop) and 120 baht per copy (sealed envelop). Please contact the MM staff for more information.

Facilities

Chulalongkorn University provides a large number of facilities and services to meet students' various needs. These range from medical care, on-campus shuttle buses, consultation services, a cooperative store, books centers, and libraries, to a sports center. A **medical center** is situated on the second floor of Chamchuri 9 building. The main library, known as **The Center of Academic Resources**, is a resource center where students can find resource materials, borrow books, and conduct research on a wide range of topics. The Center offers related technical services and support on hardware, software and all the Center of Academic Resources' network connection system equipment. The Center coordinates and manages the online Chulalinet library service available in all Faculties and Institutes' libraries and the off-campus Uninet library search service available through network connection, as well as global network connection via the internet. Internet service is provided through the Office of Information Technology. The Faculty library is located on the 7th floor, 50th Anniversary Building.

On-campus transportation is facilitated by four shuttle bus lines between Monday – Saturday; 07.00 – 19.00 hours (only Line 1 and Line 2 operates Saturday).

Line 1: Salaprakiew, Faculty of Political Sciences, Siam square (Siam Paragon Shopping Center), Faculty of Medicine, Faculty of Architecture, Faculty of Arts, and Faculty of Engineering

Line 2: Salaprakiew, Faculty of Science, Faculty of Education, Chamchuri 9, Sport center, Faculty of Architecture, Faculty of Arts, and Faculty of Engineering

Line 3: Salaprakiew, Faculty of Economics, Faculty of Commerce and Accountancy, Faculty of Science, Faculty of Architecture, Faculty of Fine Art, Faculty of Arts, and Faculty of Engineering

Line 4: Salaprakiew, Faculty of Political Sciences, Siam square (Siam Paragon Shopping Center), Faculty of Medicine, Faculty of Education, Chamchuri 9, U-Center, Faculty of Law, Faculty of Architecture, Faculty of Fine Art, Faculty of Arts, and Faculty of Engineering

In addition, **cooperative stores** offer stationery and consumer goods at reasonable prices. A range of services are also available to accommodate those who need them. The Cooperative welcomes membership subscription and part of its operating profits are returned to members in the form of dividends, activities, and privileges, while the remainder is spent on operations intended for the benefit of Chulalongkorn University and society. The **Chulalongkorn Book Center** sells textbooks and other publications. The **sports center** comprises tennis courts, an indoor gymnasium, a fitness center, and a swimming pool.
